(\*) Provision 9.2: The site has identified and quantified the risks of actual and potential adverse impacts of its business activities from pollution, and assessed and compared these risks by likelihood and severity of the outcome. However, the air emission test report of the kitchen waste gas did not cover one monitoring factor: the kitchen oil fume purify efficiency.

- (\*) Provision 13.22: The site ensured that overtime is voluntary and that the sum of regular and overtime hours does not exceed 60 hours per week, or the maximum allowed by national law, whichever is less. However, during document revision, 20 out of 40 directly hired workers' monthly overtime hours exceeded the local law limit of 36 hours, having worked up to 46-56 hours per month in February 2024.
- (\*\*) Provision 14.6: The site controlled, stored, transported, used and disposed of hazardous chemicals/materials according to relevant laws and regulations and minimised any hazards and risks to workers. However, during onsite observation, assessors noted that the site installed two non-explosion-proof switches instead of explosion-proof switches in the hazardous chemical warehouse. The finding was classed as a Minor Non-Conformance since the monitoring data of combustible gas probes were zero in the hazardous chemical warehouse.
- (\*8) Provision 14.10: The site provides safe and hygienic working environments, considering industry standards and any specific hazards identified in the risk assessment. However, during onsite observation, assessors noted that two out covers for electrical switches lacked warning signs in the dormitory area.
